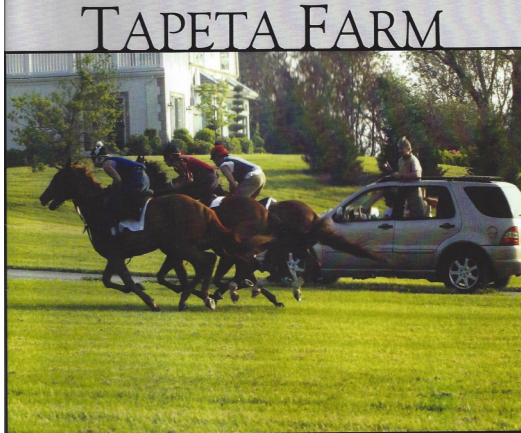

Tapeta Farm is a world-renowned race horse training facility in North East, Maryland. Designed and operated in 1998 by Michael Dickinson, an award-winning trainer, the 250 acre Tapeta Farm is also a showplace of conservation. The facility features three carefully managed turf tracks, designed for use in normal weather, dry weather and excessively wet weather, a seven furlong European-style one-turn uphill track and an oval warm up track.

Michael has won many awards in his native England and in America and horses he has trained have won hundreds of stake races. He is a two-place recipient of the Pacemaker International N. H. Trainer of the Year Award, the William Hill Golden Spur Award and the C.V. Whitney Award by the New York Turf Writers Association.
