The facility includes an 8 stall barn, 15 stall barn with attached indoor arena, outdoor sand arena and pastures. King Edward Stable offers equine training, as well as private lessons, in both the english and western disciplines. They will also travel to shows with clients to provide additional coaching. The stable and its riders have received many awards competing on the AQHA circuit. These awards include All Around Awards, World Show Qualifiers, AQHA
