Wyndham Oaks



Wyndham Oaks is a premier dressage boarding and training stable located in Montgomery County's historic horse country. Situated in the middle of 2000+ acres subject to an agricultural land preservation easement, Wyndham Oaks includes stabling for 58 horses, an Olympic-sized indoor arena, and two outdoor arenas (one for dressage and one for jumping). Designed by Blackburn Architects to take full advantage of natural light and ventilation, the buildings' features (such as skylights, exterior dutch doors on stalls, and roof ventilation every two stalls) make the experience for both horses and humans a very pleasant one. The indoor arena includes an 80 panel solar array which provides a portion of the farm's electricity. The farm includes about 40 acres in pastures as well as two heavy use round pens for bad weather. Animal waste is stored and composted in a building designed solely for that purpose. Other best practices include pasture rotation, nutrient management, and extra wide filter strips.
