Conservation practices include a concrete manure storage structure, a storm water management pond, guttering on all buildings which divert the flow of rain to the pond, automatic watering facilities in all turnout fields, and heavy use area protection.

Jamie is certified by the Maryland Department of Agriculture to prepare the official nutrient management plan for the farm. "We've spent a lot of time and money on installing and maintaining best management practices at Baywood Farms," Jamie said, "but, good conservation work pays for itself in the long run."
