

OPEN MEETING ENGAGEMENT POLICY

This policy is to establish guidelines for responding to requests and applicable allowances for person(s) to speak during a regularly scheduled monthly Board of Supervisor's Meeting.

The Washington County Soil Conservation District (WCSCD) and the District Board of Supervisors support public comment during the regularly scheduled monthly Board of Supervisor's Meeting.

Each person(s) wishing to speak, must notify the Washington County Soil Conservation District of the subject matter and their intention to speak, by the Monday, prior to the regularly scheduled Board of Supervisor's Meeting, held, the second Wednesday of each month. The requested speaker shall receive a copy of the meeting agenda.

Speakers will be limited to three minutes and speak as advised and at the discretion of the District Board of Supervisors. They shall introduce themselves, identify as to whom they are speaking for (as an individual or on behalf of an organization or other) and may provide a written copy of their comments.

No response and/or conversation will be held between the speaker and staff and/or the District Board of Supervisors.
