The Dorchester County ranch uses rotational grazing and has established pastures that include native warm-season grasses.

The Bison are provided the best of care and are raised without the use of antibiotics, growth stimulants, or hormones. They are primarily left to graze the adequate pastures, with each pasture having its own fresh water source. The Bison cows have been carefully selected from established, renowned herds, many of them having placed first, second, or third in the East's premiere Bison Show and Sale.
